Theological Impact

- 1. Our Prayers and Trust Are to Be <u>Anchored</u> in the <u>Character</u> of God
- 2. Our Prayers Are to Be Offered Confidently with Reverence, Awe, and a Willingness to Trust the Lord to Answer at the *Right Time*
- 3. If Our Prayers Are Not Answered Yes Immediately Do Not Conclude the Answer Is No, Be Patient, Wait upon The Lord and <u>Continue</u> to Pray for the Answer May Be Yes but <u>Deferred</u> of Gen. 49:18; Psalm 27:14; 33:20; 40:1-2; 130:5; Isa. 40:28-31; Lam. 3:24-26; Habk. 1:2; Heb. 10:36
- 4. If Our Prayers Are Not Answered Immediately It Does Necessarily Mean We Are Asking for the Wrong Thing or Amiss but That Is Not the <u>Right Time</u> of Gen. 18:14; Psalm 31:15; Isa. 49:8; 60:22; Acts 1:7; Rm. 5:6; Gal. 4:4
- God May <u>Delay</u> Answers to Our Prayers But He Will Never Be <u>Late</u> in Giving Us an Answer to Our Prayers of Lk. 8:49-56;

- 6. God May Delay Answering Our Prayers to Give Us Opportunities to <u>Trust</u> Him More Fully cf Prv. 3:5-6
- 7. God May Delay Answering Our Prayers to Draw us to Focus on <u>Him</u> and Not Our Circumstances cf 2 Cor. 4:18; Col. 3:1-2
- 8. God May Delay Answers to Our Prayers Because the Delay Will Bring <u>Greater Glory</u> to Him cf Jn. 11:1-45
- 9. God Is Not <u>Ignoring</u> Us or Our <u>Plight</u> When He Delays Answering our Prayers cf Ex. 2:23-25 with Ex. 12:51
