V. The Promised **Protection** of God to Believers of Psalm 91:14-16

(Points A. through C. and all sub points see previous note sheets)

D. Psalm 91:14-16 We Find a Strong Emphasis Upon God **Delivering** and **Protecting** – **Keeping** the Believer Who Has Set His Love Upon Him and Knows Him **Safe**

1. 'I Will **Deliver**' Psalm 91:14
2. 'I Will **Set Him on High**' / 'I Will Set Him **Securely on High**' / 'I Will **Protect Him**' Psalm 91:14
3. 'I Will **Deliver**' / 'I Will **Rescue**' Psalm 91:15

E. The Need for God's Promised Protection Package: Believers Who Live in Open Identification with the Lord and Endeavor by the Grace and Power of the Holy Spirit to Walk by Faith in Accordance with the Word of God and with a View to Glorifying the Lord **Will Encounter** Some Form of Opposition, Hostility, Tribulations, Afflictions, and Sufferings

1. God's Promise to Be **With** the Believer When he / she Is in **Trouble** Is **Evidence** That God's People Will Encounter **Distressful** Situations and Experience **Distress** in This World – The Hebrew Word Translated *Trouble* (צָרָה) English Transliteration *sarah* Denotes a Trouble, Adversity, Calamity Which Can Vary in Types and Degrees from Mild to Intense or the Emotion Experienced as the Result of *Distressful Circumstances* cf Gen. 35:3; 42:21; 1 Sam. 26:24; 2 Sam. 4:9; 1 Ki. 1:29; 2 Ki. 19:3; Psalm 116:3; Isa. 37:3; Jer. 4:31; 6:24; 5:43; Dan.12:1; Obad. 12, 14; Jonah 2:2; Habk. 3:16; Zeph. 1:15; 2 Tim. 4:17-18
2. **Four** Things Which Are **Manifest** by the Use of the Word 'Trouble' (צָרָה) English Transliteration *sarah* in the Scriptures
 - a. The People of God Do **Experience** Afflictions, Sufferings, Hardships, Tribulations
 - b. The Intensity of the Trouble, the Suffering, Distress **Varies** in **Degree**
 - c. Suffering, Distress Can Be Caused by Living in Open **Identification** with the Lord Which is Manifested as the Believer Walks by Faith in The Lord and **Obedience** to His Word

- d. God is **With** His People During the **Times** of Their Afflictions
3. The New Testament Is **Replete** with Passages and **Examples** that Show Believers Will Experience Hostility, Trials, Tribulations, Sufferings of Jn. 15:18-19; 16:33; Acts 4:5-21; 5:17-40; 6:9-7:60; 8:1; 12:1-5; 14:16-19 Acts 16:16-24; 18:17; 21:27-31; 2 Cor. 11:23-25; Philipp. 1:12, 28; 1 Thess. 1:5-6; 2:14; 2 Thess. 1:5; 2 Tim. 3:11-12; 4:14-18; Heb. 10:32-34; 11:35-37 James 1:2, 12; 1 Pet 1:6-7; 4:12-16; Rev. 1:9; 2:10

Theological Impact

1. God Watches Over Me and **Protects** from Danger, Harm of Which I Am **Unaware**
2. I Should Not Be Surprised When Others Respond **Negatively** to My Living in Open **Identification** with the Lord Jesus and His Word
3. I Should Not Be Surprised When I Encounter **Trials, Tribulations, Adversity,** and **Anguish** in My Life
4. I Know That God Will Either Deliver Me **Out of** Adversity or **Enable** Me to Endure It
5. I Will Never Have to Face or Endure Trials, Tribulations, Adversity, or Anguish Alone, Because the Lord Will **Always Be with Me**
6. God's Promise to Be With Me Should Remove All **Anxiety** Concerning Tomorrow
