- i.* 'Approve' Is the Translation of the Greek Verb (δοκιμάζω); English Transliteration *dokimazo*; 'to Dissect' (*i.e. take apart and carefully analyze*)
Discern and **Decide** in a Single Word **Determine**
(*the determining comes after carefully analyzing things and then determine*)
- ii.* Things That Are 'Excellent' / 'The Best' Is the Translation of the Greek Verb (διαφέρω); English Transliteration *diaphero*; the Word Literally Means 'to carry through' cf Mt. 11:16; Acts 13:49; 27:27; the Word Is Used *Figuratively* to Denote: the Most
