- Joy and Happiness Are <u>Not</u> the <u>Same</u> and Must Not Be <u>Confused</u>
  - A. Happiness Is a Temporal, Subjective Emotional Feeling in Response to and <u>Dependent</u> on <u>External</u> Circumstances One Deems to be Good, Beneficial, Pleasurable cf Gen. 30:9-13; 2 Chr. 7:10; Psalm 128:2; Eccl. 4:16; Jer. 20:15 Jonah 4:6-7
  - B. **Biblical Spiritual-Joy** Abides **Permanently** and **Independently** of External Circumstances
    - 1. **Biblical Spiritual-Joy** *Abides* When Times Are Going Well and Things Are Deemed to Be Good cf 1 Sam. 6:13; 11:9, 15; 19:5; 2 Chr. 20:27; 29:36 Job 22:18-19; Psalm 66:6; 92:4; 104:10-15; 107:41-42; Jer. 41:13; 50:11 Ezk. 25:6 Joel 2:21, 23; Mt. 2:20; 13:44; 28:8; Mk. 14:11; Lk. 1:14; 2:10 Lk. 19:6; 22:5; 23:8; 24:41, 52; Jn. 16:21; Acts 12:14

How can you not **REJOICE ALWAYS**? You are **FOREVER** saved **from** the **Penalty** of your sins!


How can you not **REJOICE ALWAYS?** You are <u>FOREVER</u> saved from the everlasting horror of <u>Hell</u>?
