- Supernatural Biblical-Spiritual Joy and Happiness Are <u>Not</u> the <u>Same</u>

Supernatural Biblical-Spiritual Joy Is a Deep Seated Supernatural State of Being of the Heart That Is Wrought by The Holy Spirit Which Makes It Possible for Those Who Trust God to Choose to Have <u>Intense Satisfied Delight</u> Because of Who He Has Revealed Himself to Be and His Salvation (see previous note sheets for passages from which this sense of Joy in the Scriptures)
