II. Look and Pray for Opportunities Proclaim the Glory and the Wondrous Works of The Lord to Others cf; 1 Chr. 16:9, 24

A. The Call to Proclaim Given in 1 Chr. 16:24

***“Declare His glory among the nations, His marvelous works among all peoples!”***  
1 Chr. 16:24

1. The Call to Praise the Lord is Expanded Beyond the People of Israel cf 1 Chr. 16:23-24, 28, 30, 31
  - a. ***“Sing unto the Lord, all the earth; show forth from day to day His salvation.”*** 1 Chr. 16:23 ***‘Earth’*** (אֶרֶץ) English Transliteration **erets** Can Denote All the Living Human Inhabitants on Earth cf Josh. 23:14 1 Ki. 2:2; 10:24; Psalm 33:8; 96:1, 9, 13; 98:9; 100:1; Isa. 26:9
  - b. ***“Declare His glory among the nations; His marvelous works among all peoples.”*** 1 Chr. 16:24 – ***‘Nations’*** (גוֹיִם) English Transliteration **goim** = People, Nations Besides Israel; the Gentiles of Deut. 26:19 Psalm 9:5; 135:15; Isa. 14:32; 49:6; Jer. 31:10; Ezk. 23:30; 30:11
  - c. ***“Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice; and let men say among the nations, the Lord reigneth.”*** 1 Chr. 16:31
2. What We Are to Proclaim: ***“Declare His glory among the nations and His marvelous works among all peoples.”*** 1 Chr. 16:24: The Word ***‘Declare’*** / ***‘Tell’*** (סָפַר) English Transliteration **saphar**
  - a. The Primary Sense of סָפַר English Transliteration **saphar** is for General Mathematical Activity cf Lev. 15:13, 28; 23:15, 16; 2 Sam. 24:10; 1 Chr. 21:2; 23:3; 2 Chr. 2:1, 16; Ezr. 1:8; Isa. 22:10; Job 14:16; 31:4; Psalm 139:17 / Think about What I Am Going to Say, Declare about the Glory of God.
  - b. The verb סָפַר English Transliteration **saphar** Is in the Piel, 2<sup>nd</sup> Person, Plural, Imperative Form = Command Calling for Every Believer to Be Actively and Intently Involved in Recounting and Proclaiming to Others cf Ex. 24:3; 9:16; 10:2; 24:3; Est. 5:11; 6:13; Psalm 22:22; 26:7; 44:1; Psalm 48:14; 66:16; 78:4; Jer. 51:10; Joel 1:3

B. What We Are to Proclaim “. . .His *Glory and His Marvelous Works*. . .”

1. The Word ‘*Glory*’ (כְּבוֹד) English Transliteration *kabod* Literally Means ‘*Heavy*’, ‘*Weighty*’ cf 1 Sam. 4:18
  - a. In This Context the Word Denotes the *Surpassing Greatness* of the Person of God and His Exalted Position, and Essence and His Works cf 1 Chr. 16:25-29, 31 cf Ex. 16:7-14; 33:18-34:7; 40:34-35; Nu. 14:22; Duet. 5:24; 1 Ki. 8:11; 2 Chr. 7:1-2; Psalm 19:1; 24:7-10; 66:2; 79:9; Psalm 108:5; 113:4; 138:5; Isa. 6:3-5; 35:2; 40:5; Isa. 42:8; 48:11; Habak. 2:14
  - b. 1 Chr. 16:27 The Words ‘*Glory*’ / ‘*Splendor*’ (הֹד) English Transliteration *hod* and ‘*Honor*’ / ‘*Majesty*’ (הָדָר) English Transliteration *hadar* Are Expressing That *Majestic Majesty* is God’s Personal State of Being and a Part of His Exalted Position cf 1 Chr. 16:31
  - c. The *Glory of God* is Connected to His Exalted Position cf Psalm 24:7-10 Psalm 57:5, 11; 102:15; 108:5, 113:4
  - d. *The Glory of God* Can Be and Is in This Context a Phrase Denoting the Totality of His Divine Essence cf Ex. 16:7-14; 33:18-34:7; 40:34-35; Nu. 14:22; 1 Ki. 8:11; 2 Chr. 5:14; 7:1-2; Ezk. 43:2-5
  - e. The *Glory of God* is Manifest in His Works cf Psalm 19:1; 97:6
2. The Wondrous Works of God cf 1 Chr. 16:9, 24; Psalm 26:7; 40:5; 71:17; Psalm 78:4-7; 96:3-6; 105:2; *Wondrous Works* in the Old Testament Were a Manifestation of God’s ‘*Goodness*’ and His ‘*Loving Kindness*’ to His People cf Ex. 3:20; Psalm 17:7; 31:21; 40:5; 106:7-10, 21-22; 107:8, 15, 21, 23-31; 111:4; Psalm 136:4; 145:7
